- Graphics driver releases will transition to 20H1 driver support after 19H2 PR11 release in WW17'20.
- 20H1 drivers will continue to support both Legacy [non-DCH] and DCH [with IGCC] drivers.
- 20H1 PV drivers are certified on 20H1 and 19H1/H2 OS and are validated at ingredient level.
 - PV1 drivers 100.7987 [Legacy] and 100.7988 [DCH] released in WW18'20 are meeting Microsoft* publishing criteria and will be posted to Windows Update as 2-ID coverage driver.
 - OEMs may use these drivers for web update.
 - PV2 drivers 100.8189 [Legacy] and 100.8190 [DCH] released in WW19'20 have latest OEM bug fixes.
 - OEMs may use this or subsequent drivers for 19H2 design launch and web update.
 - OEMs should align to Comet Lake or Ice Lake platform dashboard or MoW for 20H1 design launch.
